This decision will add Houston to our schedule as Houston is an East event. We will also add St. Louis and Indianapolis to our schedule upping our event participation from 9 events to 11 events.

With that being said, the **Tamer - Hooters - Cumberland - 2 Wheel Outlet** team was hoping for a good round of racing in Anaheim. Both Vernon and Michael made it easily from the day show to the night show.

In qualifying, both riders struggled to find rhythm and performed below expectations moving them both to the LCQ. Knowing we had an uphill battle on our hands in the LCQ, both riders rode much better than in their qualifiers, but neither could get the job done and advance to the main event.

"This is very frustrating", said Maret. "On one hand, I have to take some responsibility as the program is not competitive right now due to the late start for the season. On the other hand, neither Michael or Vernon rode well enough to even be on a team right now, as our program is more competitive than they showcased."

On a positive note, Michael Blose discovered his arm pump issues and did not experience any arm pump at Anaheim.

Next week, the team moves to Houston where the switch is to the 450 class.
